TREES Residents in Flintham can make their properties even greener by applying for free trees from Rushcliffe Borough Council for a fifth year running.

Over 9,000 trees have been distributed since the start of the campaign in 2018 and now a further 1,600 field maple and hazel trees are available without charge for those who live in the Borough. It's part of R B C strategy to provide sustainable environments in line with the Borough's significant housing and employment growth in the coming years. Household are encouraged to apply as soon as possible given anticipated high demand and can apply for up to two trees by visiting
